

## **February 26**

Exodus 20:1-17

In these verses, we find the Ten Commandments.

*Question to Consider:*

Which of these commandments is the most difficult for you to obey?

*Prayer:*

Merciful God, your law is so good and I know that my life is better when I obey you. Fill me with your Spirit and help me to be more obedient. I pray in the name of Jesus, Amen.

## **February 27**

Exodus 32:1-14

It did not take the Israelites long to turn away from God and become disobedient.

*Question to Consider:*

Moses pleaded with God to not destroy the Israelites and even though God had intended to, he said yes to Moses and did bring them to destruction. Do you believe that God answers prayer?

*Prayer:*

Father God, help me to pray faithfully to you, and to trust that you will always hear my prayers. In Jesus' name I pray, Amen.

## **February 28**

Exodus 32:15-20, 30-35

In these passages, we read of Moses' anger at the people and God's decision about how to punish them. (NOTE: in chapter 34 we learn that new tablets were inscribed with the law)

*Question to Consider:*

In anger, Moses threw the stone tablets to the ground, destroying them. Has your anger ever gotten the best of you? When? What happened?

*Prayer:*

Forgiving God, there are times when I feel angry. Please help me to control my anger and not let my anger take control of me. I pray in the name of Jesus, Amen.
