### Blessed Are Those Who Hunger and Thirst

Today we continue in our teaching series going through the Beatitudes. We hear Jesus' words: *Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be filled.* Hunger is a very personal thing. The things that I crave are not necessarily the same things that you crave. This beatitude isn't about our individual hunger, it is about getting our hearts and minds in sync with God's work in this world, and our role in living in a right relationship with God and neighbor. We will continue to wrestle with the tension of how Jesus says things are in the kingdom of heaven versus what we think, and how we live as citizens of earthly kingdoms.
